NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Dogs Eligible to Enter the AKC FETCH Test

- The test is open to all dogs at least 6 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL number, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners Program.
- Females in season my enter. They will run at the end of the day. Should wear panties to prevent soiling the test area.
- Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to enter provided, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the test. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs are allowed to enter so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, and the dog doesn't appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses Dogs may wear slip collars, buckle collars, and Martingales in the AKC Fetch test. They may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, muzzles or body harnesses. Leashes need to be 4 to 6 feet in length. *No flexi leads allowed on the property.* Dog must be on leash at all times except when being tested.

Grounds will be available from 9:00 am to Completion of the test

<u>Please keep the trial site clean.</u> We ask your cooperation so the we may continue using the facility for future tests. Please pick up after your dog.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination.
